How to change Race Coordinator Fuel Level images

Downloading the files

1. Visit the <http://www.ozscaleracers.com> support page to download the required **Zip** file
2. Go to the **Useful RC Fuel** images section
3. Click the required **Download** button to grab the **ZIP** file
4. Unzip / extract the ZIP file into the **C:\Program Files (x86)\Race Coordinator\data\images\ui** folder
5. Select **YES** when you are prompted to overwrite / replace the existing files.

Useful RC Fuel Images To Enhance Your Racing Experience

Standard Fuel Images
Identical to original RC gauge but with solid black background and outline so you can see low fuel levels in red lane.

RC Fuel Gauges 2
This version uses a real Analog fuel gauge in order to give that authentic appearance. - (17 images).

RC Fuel Gauges 3
This version uses a real LED fuel gauge in order to give a more modern appearance- (11 images).

Now for the clean-up of fuel images and attributes.

The fuel gauge files often contain a different number of images which so when updating you may need to delete any extra image files contained in the previous gauge version. To do this as well as setting the Read-only attribute to prevent files from being overwritten when upgrading Race Coordinator in future, simply follow the steps below.

6. Select / highlight all the remaining unwanted **Fuel** files (eg, Fuel_0.png – Fuel_16.png)
7. **Right Click** the mouse button and **Left Click** on the **Properties** tab to open the Properties Window
8. Click the **Read-only** attribute box
9. Click OK to save changes
10. Done
